Ministry Center Food Pantry ...

Our volunteers help us in filling grocery carts with food, helping clients take the carts to their cars, stock the shelves and help with the clerical needs. On Mondays, we have a larger crew of volunteers who unload from the supply trucks and clean any grocery items that may need it before they are stocked on the shelves. We also have volunteers who pick up the day-old bakery items from HY-VEE. There are volunteer counselors on staff who spend time with the clients and listen to their needs.

Our volunteers develop solid relationships with other volunteers and the clients they serve. They also have the satisfaction of knowing they are providing a needed service to people living in poverty in our county. It would not be possible to operate the food pantry without our outstanding group of volunteers.

The food pantry is open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:30 to 11:30 and the last Tuesday of the month from 5:30 PM to 7:30PM. Our Monday crew starts at 7:30 AM and works until 11:30 AM.
