

STATION SPOTLIGHT TRANSPORTATION.....

LCHC Volunteer Services has been offering rides to and from medical appointments since we were known as RSVP. That was many years ago and this program has been very beneficial to many in our community. Our Transportation volunteers help many in the community that do not have vehicles or may not be able to drive. We also take donations to cover the cost of gas for those that cannot afford to pay.

Did you know there are other transportation opportunities in Lucas County? Veterans can receive free transportation to medical appointments by calling (641) 774-4611. Road to Recovery (American Cancer Center) provides transportation for individuals that need a ride to and from cancer treatments. Call 1-800-227-2345 to see if service is available or to become a volunteer. 10-15 Transit is a transportation service open to the general public of all ages, including persons with disabilities. Rates are very reasonable for rides inside the Chariton city limits and inside the Lucas County line. They are available for all types of rides, not just medical appointments. To schedule a ride call (641) 683-2024 or 1-800-227-6390.
