

SALVATION ARMY RED KETTLE CAMPAIGN.....

The Holidays are here, and the Lucas County Salvation Army Service Extension Unit is in full force with their annual Red Kettle Campaign. This requires not only the generous monetary donations of the community, but it means we need people to man the Red Kettles on Fridays and Saturday of December in Chariton.

Last Christmas season \$20,250 was raised with 90% remaining for use in Lucas County. Individuals and families are eligible for vouchers, up to \$150 each, twice a year. This financial assistance goes toward utilities, rent, food, medicine, emergency lodging and gas for medical appointments. The other 10% remains with the divisional office and then funds may be requested to help families recover from the devastation of a fire or natural disaster.

LCHC Volunteer Services has adopted to man the Red Kettle on December 6, 2019 from 9 AM through 4 PM at True Value. This location is very appealing to volunteer at as it will be indoors, and a chair can be provided if necessary. This will allow volunteers to be comfortable while helping a worthy cause for our community. Our shifts are currently full!
