Share Care Model

Through our "Share Care" model, Lucas County Health Center is proud to partner with MercyOne Midwives and UnityPoint Health - Des Moines to provide pregnancy care close to home. But what does that mean and how does it work?

The "Share Care" model means that women who are pregnant can receive their prenatal care with Dr. Greg Cohen or Sharon Squibb, Certified Nurse Midwife, right here at LCHC Medical Clinic.

This care encompasses the same aspects of prenatal care at a larger facility, including ultrasounds, labwork, and education. You can be seen as early as your first positive pregnancy test to help ensure that your pregnancy gets off to the best start.

The "Share Care" model lets you skip the hours of driving and taking time off work for prenatal care appointments. We'll help you enjoy your pregnancy with convenient appointments, ensure a smooth transition when it's time to deliver, and provide personalized care to you and your baby after you return home.

How It Works

During your pregnancy, you will be able to receive prenatal care at LCHC Medical Clinic in Chariton until your 3rd trimester (36--38 weeks.) Appointments will include all the same aspects of prenatal care at a larger facility, including ultrasounds.

During that time, Dr. Cohen or Sharon will also find the provider best fit for your delivery, either at Mercy Midwives or UnityPoint Health - Des Moines and work closely with them to create a customized delivery and care plan for you and your baby.

After birth, you can return to LCHC Medical Clinic for all of your postnatal (after birth) care, including:

- · Weight checks for your baby
- · Help with breastfeeding
- Education about what to expect in the postpartum period, including recovery, baby blues, and postpartum depression
- Birth control options
