Being able to access your medical information is vital to managing your health. In an effort to improve patient access to health data, we are launching an enrollment and education campaign for MyChart – our online patient portal.

MyChart allows patients to:

- view their personal health information and medical records
- Send a message to their provider or care team
- Schedule or request appointments
- View labs, x-rays, and other test results
- Refill or request prescriptions
- Make payments to your accounts

With an online website and a mobile app, MyChart gives patients easy 24/7 access on the go, making sure you always have your medical information on hand.

Our first goal is to get 75% of our own staff members enrolled. To do this, we have identified “super users” within our facility who can assist our staff members with getting enrolled. If you would like assistance, please contact Kami Welch or Becky Runnells and they will help you get enrolled.

We will be launching “Phase II” of this campaign in November - increasing our patient registration and usage!

Winterfest Update:


It is with heavy hearts that A-Team has decided we will not have Winterfest this year due to COVID.
