

VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

Title/Position: Environment Services Partner

Goal of Position: Support and maintain the facility by assisting the Environmental Services Department to

complete indoor and outdoor tasks.

Duties:

1. Work with the Environmental Services Manager to identify tasks to complete, indoors and outdoors.

- 2. Assist with infection control by wiping down high touch areas to reduce the spread of germs.
- 3. Fold linens and restock linen closets to help maintain continuity of care for patients and the facility.
- 4. Sweep and help keep outdoor sidewalks and doorways clean and clear of debris.
- 5. Help with trash pick up indoors and outdoors to maintain a tidy facility.
- 6. Check areas that may need restocked with toilet paper and paper towels.
- 7. Complete other duties as agreed upon by Environmental Services Manager and individual.

Time Frame:

Length of commitment: 12 months and at least one shift per week, but more is preferred

Length of shift: 2-3 hours

Scheduling: 9am-11:30am Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday

No Holidays or weekends

Worksite: Facility wide

Minimum age: 14

- 3. Must be able to read and write
- 4. Good verbal communication skills

- 8. Communicate adequately with patients and staff as necessary
- 9. Understand and follow safety guidelines
- 10. Cell phone usage is discouraged while performing duties

- 12. Must understand and follow Lucas County Health Center's Core Values

- 13. Must be able to stand and bend for extended periods of time
- 14. Must be willing to complete duties outdoors
