VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

Title/Position: Surgical Procedure Partner

Goal of Position: Provide hospital, patient and family assistance before, during and after surgical procedures.

Duties:

- 1. Greet and escort patients
- 2. Push patients in wheelchair
- 3. Provide patient amenities (water, tissues, etc.)
- 4. Make sure patient has access to snack and drink during recovery
- 5. Monitor (non-medical) patient for signs of distress and report any issues to surgical staff
- 6. Stay with patients while family members bring car to front of Hospital
- 7. Run errands within the hospital
- 8. Maintain tidy waiting room
- 9. Keep water/coffee area stocked and tidy
- 10. Promote and have basic knowledge of Clinic, Hospital, and community support for patient assistance

- 8. Understand and follow safety guidelines
- 9. Understand the Volunteer Handbook and all Clinic and Hospital policies and procedures

- 11. Must be able to sit for extended periods of time
- 12. Must be able to push patients in wheelchair
