### Medicare Prescription Payment Plan

The Medicare Prescription Payment Plan allows you to spread your prescription drug costs into monthly payments throughout the year. Important: This program does not reduce the amount you pay for medications, but it may make costs easier to manage by allowing you to pay over time.
